RULES AND REGULATIONS of the 6th International Art Exhibition Still life in photography – Częstochowa 2014

- 1. The aim of the contest is an artistic use of still life in photographythe subject that is usually connected with painting. The organizers are waiting for the works that present still life in either a classic, still form or processed digitally.
- 2. The exhibition has an open character- all photographers can participate.
- 3. Each participant can send maximum 5 black-and-white and colorful works. Multi-picture sets will be treated as one work, provided that they are thematically coherent and that it is clearly stated in the application form.
- 4. The photographs may be taken with the use of any technique, in the format no smaller than 20x30 cm and not larger than 30x45 cm. The pictures cannot be framed or glued. Participants are requested to enclose CD with the digital version of the works (*.bmp or *.tiff file, picture definition 300 dpi) - for documentation, qualifying and publishing purposes.
- 5. Each work must be numbered, entitled and contain name, surname and address of residence and country of the author. Photographs must contain numbers and titles that correspond with the ones on the application form.
- Participation fee collected from authors: PLN 40 (for foreign 6. authors - EUR 12), must be paid to the account of the City Art Gallery in Częstochowa:

The copy of payment confirmation must be enclosed with works.

- Works that do not meet the requirements specified in points 3-6 will 7. be returned to authors without submitting them to the Jury's assessment. Participation fee is non-refundable.
- 8. Participation payment guarantees all participants that they will receive the exhibition catalogue and that their works will be returned by post. The catalogues will be sent together with works within the dates specified in the rules and regulations.
- 9. Works must be sent to the Organizer's address:

- 11. The Jury is authorized to qualify single pictures from the author's set to awards and exhibition. The Jury's decisions are final.
- 12. The contest laureates will receive the following awards: Grad Prix of the President of Częstochowa; Gold, Silver and Bronze - medals of FIAP, honorable distinctions of FIAP; Gold, Silver and Bronze -The Republic of Poland Photo-club medals- Association of Artists in Warsaw; Organizer's awards. The works that receive financial awards become the Organizer's property.
- 13. Authors agree for the free-of-charge use of the works sent to the contest, in connection with exhibition promotion in the following: mass media (press, radio, TV), Internet, promotional materials (poster, invitation) and filming and other forms of recording the exhibition for documentation purposes. Authors declare that the use of the above-mentioned materials will not infringe copyrights of the third persons and in the case of claims, due to copyrights infringement; authors undertake to release Gallery from the liability in connection to the above.
- 14. Authors authorize Organizer (free of charge) to use works in the exposition aims based on separate agreements with other exhibition organizers within the dates specified in the rules and regulations.
- 15. Sending works equals the full acceptance of the rules and regulations.
